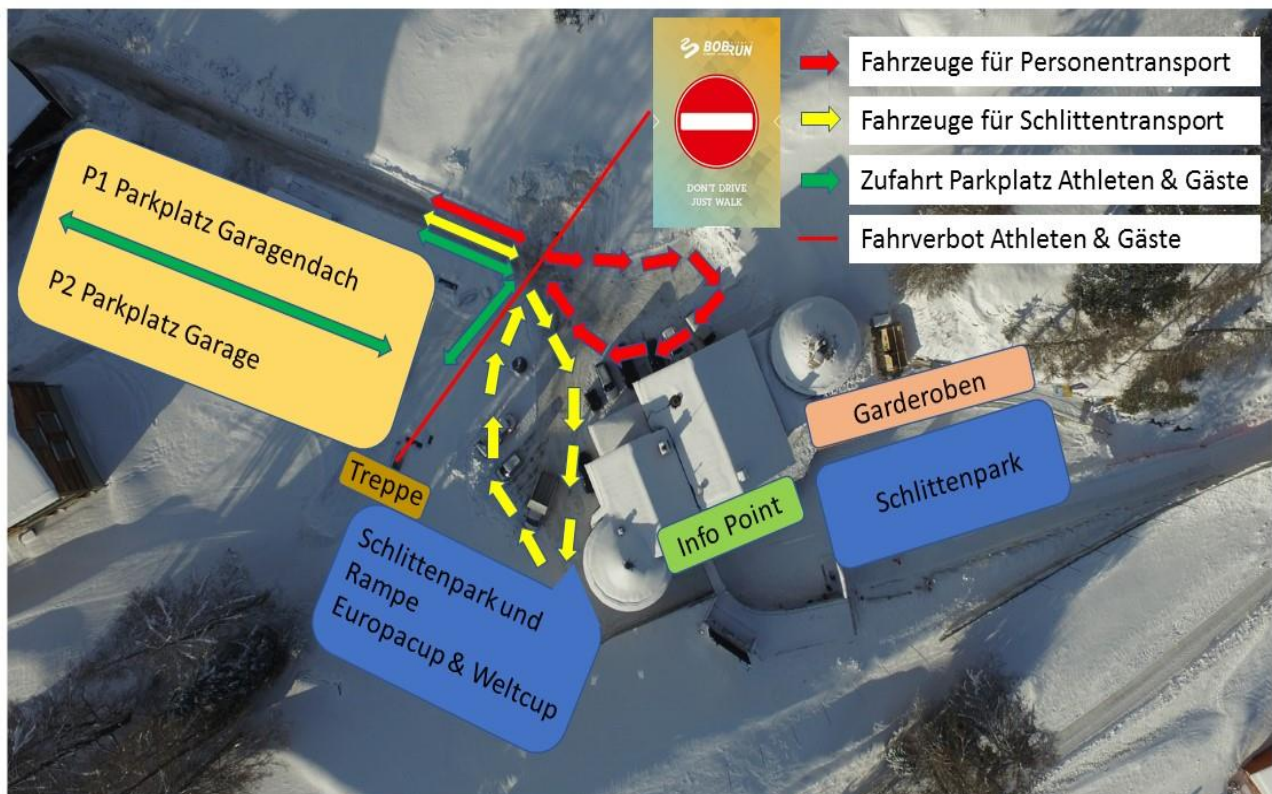

Parking place

You will find parking places at the "meeting point" in the finish area of the Olympia Bob Run (Celerina). You have the possibility to take the official transport to the start area. Please ask the staff of the Olympia Bob Run at the finish area.

Parking places (also for trailers) can be used only during the operating hours.

Furthermore, there are parking places in the start area (address above). Please note, that stopping, parking, loading and offloading in front of or beside the start house is forbidden. Below you can find the traffic regulation in the start area.



Changement of break man, sled rental and so on

Changement of break man, sled rental and so on can be done in your portal. In case of short-term modification, please write an email to sekretariat@olympia-bobrun.ch or contact the staff in the Info Point.

Start time

The start time will be communicated by SMS. Therefore it is important, that you put the right telephone number (with country code) in your portal. In case you haven't received any message until 7pm (on the day before the concerned runs), you can check the start time online at www.olympia-bobrun.ch.

Training

Under normal conditions minimum two runs per training session are provided. If the conditions allow it, more runs will be provided. Swiss athletes are prioritised.

Payment:

Swiss athletes: At the end of the season an invoice for the completed runs (trainings and races) will be sent.

Foreign athletes: The completed runs (trainings and races) have to be paid in the Info Point before departure.

Organisation trainings or race runs

The start list is shown in the start area. Please control all informations (e.g. name pusher, discipline) and inform, in case of mistake, the staff of the Olympia Bob Run (Chief of the start or staff in the Info Point).

The start order has to be respected. Please be in time in the start zone.

Before the start of your run it is absolutely mandatory that you follow the process listed below:

- Listen if your name and your start location are announced correctly; e.g. "Max Müller, Top".
- Wait until the announcement "The track is clear".
- Control that the light switches to green and that you hear the start signal.

If all these points are correct, you can start. If any of these points are not in place, do not start and contact the chief of the start or the staff of the Olympia Bob Run.

Safety information (see also the GTC)

- The track management has the right to neglect the start of an athlete or a team due to technical, health or other concerns. This decision has to be respected.
- In case of a crash, the staff of the track decides if e.g. the ambulance is called.
- Leave the track after your run as soon as possible.
- Never walk in the track (for track walks and so on) without contacting the staff of the Olympia Bob Run.
